Focus on changes from the 2025 call, how resubmissions are evaluated, and how to improve the overall proposal.

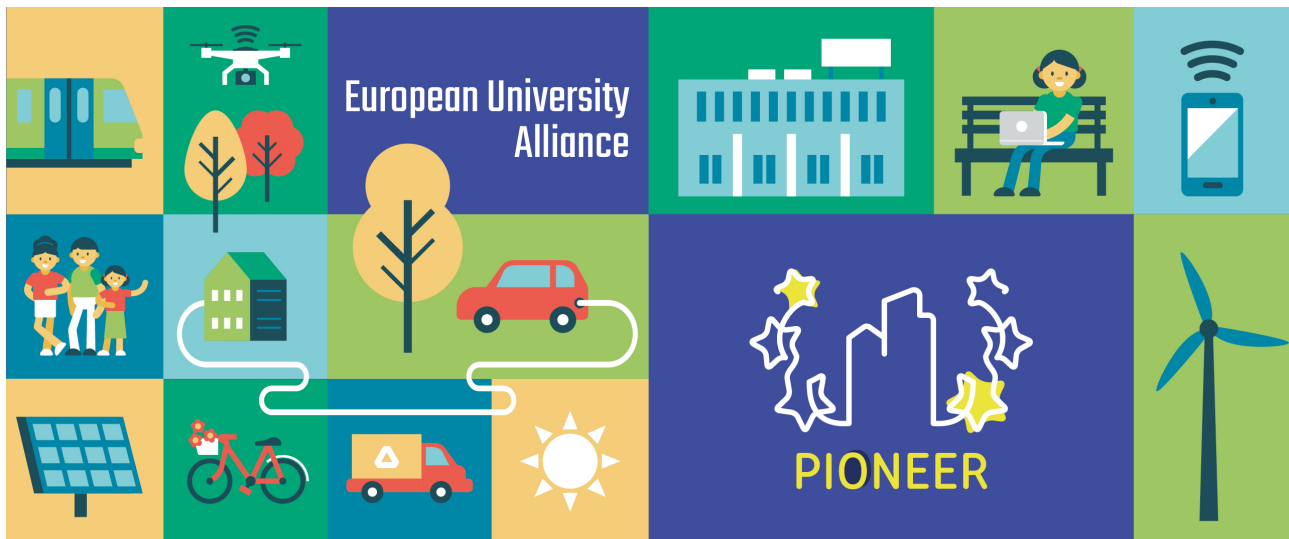
